It is the responsibility of the student to contact the instructor and provide a legitimate reason. The percentage of the exam will be counted towards the next exam. The midterm grade will be posted shortly on My Grade after the exam.

### **Final Exam**

The final exam is 3 hours long consisting of 60 multiple choice questions and 8 problems. The final grade will be posted about a week after the exam. All the materials must be returned after the exam including exam questions. If you miss the final exam, you will need to apply for a deferred exam within three days of the exam from your College.
