

Preparing For School Budget Worksheet

Monthly Expenses

Rent & Utilities

(if living at home and not paying rent/utilities or are living in residence, please put "0". Rent/utilities can be expected to be \$1,000 - \$1,500/month.)

Food

(this includes: groceries, dining out, fast food, etc. If not staying in residence and on the meal plan you can estimate \$300-\$500/month. If you are staying in residence you will be on a meal plan and only need to account for extra snacks, dining out, and fast food.)

Transportation & Vehicle

(this includes: insurance, fuel, vehicle payments, etc.)

Cell Phone & Electronics

(this includes: monthly payment for phone or other electronics)

Child Care

(if you do not have a dependent(s), please put "0")

Entertainment & Subscriptions

(this includes: Netflix, Disney, Prime, Music, Wi-Fi or any other monthly subscription you have. You may also want to set aside extra for outings with friends. If you are unsure of how much to calculate for, use \$150 as a guideline)

(any other anticipated or non-anticipated expenses such as vehicle trouble, etc.)
